A professional, premium interior design budget is divided into four main parts. If your designer or carpenter is only talking about plywood and laminate costs, they are missing the bigger picture! Here is how your total budget is distributed:

<b>35% - 45%</b> CIVIL & FIXED WORK	<b>30% - 40%</b> FURNITURE & FF&E	<b>10% - 15%</b> DESIGN & FEES	<b>10% - 15%</b> SAFE CONTINGENCY
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- **Civil & Fit-out (Hard Costs):** This includes all raw material and structural changes like breaking walls, doing new plastering, POP false ceiling work, tile flooring, main electrical wiring, and plumbing pipelines.
